Title I-A: School Level Parent Involvement Policy Implementation Plan

 - Coordinate written materials to parents regarding this program (overview of Title I-A program)
 - Coordinate or share parent involvement activities between parents and school staff
5. Riverview Elementary School will take the following actions to conduct, with the involvement of parents, an annual evaluation of the content and effectiveness of this parental involvement policy in improving the quality of the school's educational program. 6. Riverview Elementary School will build the school's capacity for strong parental involvement. 7. The school will provide materials and training to help parents work with their children to improve their children's academic achievement, such as literacy training and math strategies, as appropriate, to foster parental involvement.
8. Riverview Elementary School will reach out and work with parents, as equal partners, in the value and utility of contributions in how to implement and coordinate parent programs and to build ties between parents and the school.
9. The school will, to the extent feasible and appropriate, coordinate parental involvement programs and activities with the local Head Start Program.
10. If and when Riverview Elementary School enrolls students who do not speak English, the school will make every effort to provide information in a manner that is understandable to them and to their parents.
